- Short stories must not exceed 500 words in length.
- All entries must be submitted with a competition entry form.
- The Winners and Runners-up in each category will be notified by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2016.
- The winners agree for their names to be displayed in future Worthing Borough Council correspondence, appear on the W3PF website and be forwarded to local newspapers.
- The judges decision is final.

### Art Competition Rules

- This competition is open to all young people aged 11 to 19 living in the Adur and Worthing area (on or before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015.)
- The closing date for receipt of submitted entries is Friday 29<sup>th</sup> January 2016. All entries must be forwarded by this date to the Adur & Worthing Borough Youth Council.
- Entries must be on either an A4 or A3 sized paper.
- All entries must be submitted with a competition entry form.
- The Winners and Runners-up in each category will be notified by Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2016.
- The winners agree for their names to be displayed in future Worthing Borough Council correspondence, appear on the W3PF website and be forwarded to local newspapers.
- The judges decision is final.
