TELEVISION'S top comedy star Jimmy Tarbuck comes to Worthing this evening (Friday), when he brings his not-to-be-missed Tarby and Friends Show to the Pier Pavillon.

Jimmy will be joined by Kenny Lynch, Johnny Moore, Mike Burton and The Johnny Wiltshire Orchestra.

Hailed as the greatest stand-up comedian in the country today, Jimmy has established himself as a household name through such successful series as Live From Her Majesty's and Tarby and Friends.

He has also made hilarious appearances on the Bob Hope Gala Night, Parkinson, Des O'Connor Tonight, All Star Secrets and Bring Me Sunshine - his special tribute to Eric Morecambe.

He has been honoured by

his showbusiness colleagues and received the Showbusiness Personality of the Year award from the Variety Club of Great Britain in 1988.

Liverpool-born Jimmy was the son of a bookmaker and went through an

assortment of jobs before joining a touring rock 'n' roll show as compere. He made his first television appearance on Comedy Bandbox in 1963.

It was, however, his compering of Sunday Night At The London Palladium

that led to national stardom at the age of only 22.

More and more television followed and today Jimmy is also known for such game shows as Winner Takes All and Tarby's Frame Game.
