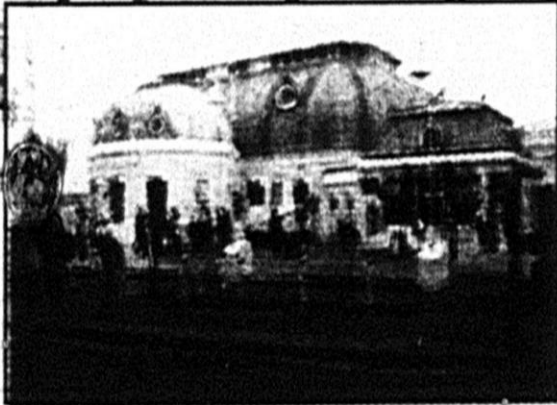

19th century Pier



THIS was Worthing Pier in 1890, when it was entered between two attractive kiosks constructed by a Mr Alfred Crouch in 1884.

In those days, the public had to pay to get on the Pier and one of the kiosks was used as a toll-house while the other was a gift

shop and post office.

The present Pier Pavilion and its attached satellite kiosks replaced them in 1925-26.

This building work followed the Pier's purchase by the town from its hitherto private ownership in 1921.
