Boy, 11, robbed of mobile phone on pier

AN 11-year-old boy was attacked for his mobile phone as he rode his bike along Worthing Pier last week.

The boy was cycling along the pier with friends on Thursday at 4.15pm, when he stopped to watch some youths

jumping off the pier, into the water, and then climbing up.

He was then attacked physically and verbally, all for his Nokia 8210 mobile phone.

It is believed there were five or six youths, aged between 11 and 16. They were on the pier for most of the afternoon and may have upset other members of the public. Anyone with more information should contact PC Lee Cook on 0845 6070999.



●Police are appealing for help in tracking down a youth who damaged the wall of a King Edward Avenue house on Saturday.

The youth damaged the wall at about 12.20am and then ran off towards the east. He was described as 16 to 17 years old, white, 6ft tall and of thin build. He was wearing dark clothes.
