- There are 3 categories: Lower Primary for pupils aged 5 – 7, Upper Primary for pupils aged 7 to 11. Secondary for pupils aged 11 – 19 (on or before 1st September 2014.)
- The closing date for receipt of submitted entries is Friday 19th June 2015. All entries must be forwarded by this date to The Worthing Borough Youth Council.
- All entries must be submitted with a competition entry form.
- The Winners and Runners-up in each category will be notified by Monday 29th June 2015.
- The winners agree for their names to be displayed in future Worthing Borough Council correspondence, appear on the W3PF website and be forwarded to local newspapers.
- The judges decision is final.

- Poems can be any length but must reflect one of the subjects listed below.
- Short stories must not exceed 500 words in length (primary) or 1000 words in length (secondary.)
- All entries must be submitted with a competition entry form.
- The Winners and Runners-up in each category will be notified by Saturday 4th July 2015.
- The winners agree for their names to be displayed in future Worthing Borough Council correspondence, appear on the W3PF website and be forwarded to local newspapers.
- The judges decision is final.
